Youth Trip Covenant

This covenant is meant to ensure your safety and the usefulness of the trip. While attending a First Baptist Lavon Youth trip you are expected to:

- 1. Go as a servant disciple of Jesus Christ and will adopt that attitude when dealing with my fellow youth and the people I meet during the trip.
- 2. Accept and submit to the leadership role and authority of the youth leaders and promise to abide by his or her decisions as they concern this trip.
- 3. Refrain from using tobacco, alcoholic beverages, or illegal drugs at any time during the trip.
- 4. Come home the same way you left.
- 5. Abstain from making derogatory comments or getting involved in arguments.
- 6. Attend all meetings, both prior to departure and during the trip.
- 7. Refrain from meddling, complaining and using obscene or insensitive humor.
- 8. Adhere to the dress code established for your trip.
- 9. Make sure the group leaders know where you are at all times. You should never wander off alone.
- 10. Interact with all members of your group, not just those members that you knew before the trip.
- 11. Fast from dating for the duration of the trip. Do not seek out romantic relationships while on a trip.
- 12. Respect the advice you are given from a leader.
- 13. Refrain from any other behavior or activity that would hinder your ministry or the ministry of your team during the term of your service.
- 14. Refrain from excessive or inappropriate phone/device use if it is allowed on the trip.

I have read, understand, and agree to the above standards of conduct. I understand and agree that in the event that my conduct is considered so unsatisfactory that it jeopardizes the success of the trip, and that mediation during the trip has failed to correct my behavior, that my involvement on the trip will end and I will return home immediately at my own/parent's expense.
